The Compact rescue system is designed to address life-threatening emergencies such as severe bleeding, airway obstructions, and other traumatic injuries that can become fatal without intervention.

Real-time Instructions at Your Fingertips

The Compact rescue system pairs with the Mobilize Rescue app, which users download and access from their smartphone. The app provides real-time guidance through simple interactive prompts, written instructions, and visual cues that show rescuers how to use the medical supplies in the kit to provide care during a medical emergency. The kit includes a multi-user app license so anyone with the Mobilize Rescue app will be prepared to help.

Compact and lightweight, this bleeding control and airway management kit is handy to keep at work or take with you on the go. Military-grade nylon casing protects supplies in a range of environments and Molle straps allow you to easily attach it to a rucksack, belt, or other travel pack.
